Type of Practice

Solely equine practice with busy ambulatory and hospital components. Field cases focus on preventative care with an emphasis in sports medicine. Surgery includes elective and 24 hour emergency service. Reproduction cases include fresh and frozen semen, stallion collection and embryo transfer.

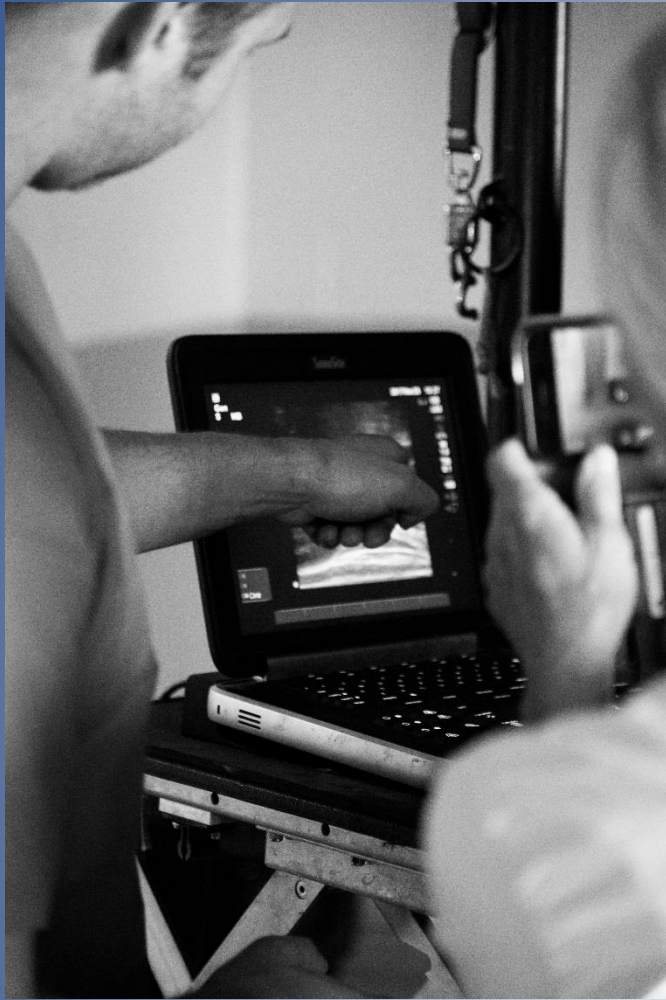
