

EXTERNSHIP PROGRAM

Our practice is located in premier horse country with world class competitions such as Dressage at Devon, Fair Hill International, Plantation Field, the Devon Horse Show, PA Hunt Cup and Cheshire and Radnor Hunts. Our veterinarians have FEI certification to treat at FEI events and do so regularly. In the summer of 2012, UEA completed construction of their new state-of-the-art clinic and surgical facility. The clinic features four private outpatient exam areas, ten stalls, reproduction and isolation facilities, an outdoor ring and round pen, a pharmacy and a full service laboratory. Additional equipment includes digital radiography, digital ultrasound, lameness locator, arthroscope, video endoscope and gastroscope, shockwave, power dental equipment, regenerative laser, ECG and an in-house clinical laboratory.

Insurance Requirements: AVMA Student Liability Insurance

Responsibilities: Externs are strongly encouraged to participate in after-hours emergencies, surgeries and in-patient treatments.

Estimated Externship Workload: 40+ hours per week including evenings and weekends to assist/observe after hours emergencies and surgeries in the hospital and in the field.

Duration: Typically two weeks but exceptions can be made based on availability. More than 1 extern will be accepted from March-October. Externs are encouraged to apply year round.

Goals of the Externship: Gain hands on experience with a wide variety of diagnostic and treatment disciplines. As an extern you will be exposed to a large variety of cases including reproduction, healthy and sick neonatal evaluations, medicine, surgery, chiropractic, acupuncture and lameness exams. Our aim is to provide students with a realistic example of a successful ambulatory and surgical practice.

Living Quarters: A furnished two bedroom apartment is available. Amenities include full kitchen, high speed internet Wi-Fi and air conditioning.
